Mark one with halves, another with quarters, another with thirds, another with sixths, another with eighths.</p> <p>Extension: Write some equivalent fractions on the number line.</p>	<p>Reading: Read for 20 minutes a day</p>	<p>English: Using the "Rodney Loses It!" text from last week, highlight the who, what, where that are located in the orientation of the book.</p> <p>Is there a hook sentence that engages the audience with the story and makes them want to keep reading?</p>	<p>Word Study: There is a common known spelling rule "I comes before e except after c". This is actually very inaccurate.</p> <p>Find 5 examples of words where this rule doesn't apply.</p>
