Eg. <math>\frac{1}{4}</math>, <math>\frac{2}{4}</math>, <math>\frac{3}{4}</math>, 1, 1 and <math>\frac{1}{4}</math>, 1 and <math>\frac{2}{4}</math> etc.</p>
<p><b>Housework:</b> Ask Mum or Dad what their least favourite chore is and do that for them this week.</p>	<p><b>Computer:</b> Play some of the fraction games on the blog for Term 2 or Math Playground.</p>	<p><b>Riddle:</b> A prisoner is told "If you tell a lie we will hang you; if you tell the truth we will shoot you."
