Learning Intention: We are learning to.....

The Task: Why did the great journeys of exploration occur?

Using the above “big question” you are to research an explorer from prior to 1850. You are to develop questions to research and find the relevant information to answer them. You are then to put all of the information together in some form of presentation to the class. This can be anything from a powerpoint to a poster, book creator etc.

Due Date: Presentations will be made in Week 8 and the order of presentations will be drawn randomly from the sticks.

Suggested Time Guide: This is only a suggestion but you may like to use it to ensure you are on track to present in week 8. (this will be the only homework this term)

- Week 1 – Choose an explorer from prior to 1850
- Week 2 – Design questions to answer – What do you want to know about the explorer – Think about the big question
- Week 3 - Research and take notes on each question
- Week 4 – Write notes into proper paragraphs
- Week 5 – Select relevant pictures to put on the presentation
- Week 6 - Put presentation together
- Week 7 - Practice
- Week 8 – Present to the class
