<b>Compulsory Tasks</b>			
<b>Maths</b> Complete the multiplication and division problems	<b>English</b> Write a newspaper report about Clean Up Australia Day. Hook sentence. Introduce what it is – give some background. Advise it is important that we do it. Persuade people to join in. Strong finish.	<b>Reading</b> Read for 30 minutes each day.	<b>Typing</b> Using the links on the blog do some typing practice. Try for at least 5-10 minutes a day.

<b>Helping at Home</b> Help Mum and Dad cook dinner one night this week.	<b>English</b> Choose a book you have already read or read a new one. Write a short book review about it to share with the class and potentially publish on Oliver.	<b>iPads</b> Discuss with your parents about cyber safety. What are the important things to remember? What should you do if someone you don't know tries to talk to you on the internet or through a game?	<b>Zones of Regulation</b> Write down a time when you were in the Blue Zone (tired/sad). Explain what happened. Describe your reaction and whether it was the appropriate action or not.
